Sessions I and II

Each time we participate in the Eucharist we have the opportunity to enter more deeply into the mystery we encounter there. From the days of the early Church Fathers the experience of mystagogical reflection has been one that reveals the significance and deeper meaning of that which we celebrate. During two plenary sessions Father Richard Fragomeni will lead participants through the revised text of the Eucharistic Prayer for Reconciliation with the aim of helping them understand the text, structure and theology of this prayer while growing in their Eucharistic spirituality.



**Rev. Richard Fragomeni, S.T.B., M.A.,
M. Music, Ph.D.**

Reverend Richard Fragomeni is a presbyter of the Diocese of Albany, New York. He currently serves as Associate Professor of Liturgy and Preaching at the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago. His work involves him in conversation with theology, interpretation theory, and poetry. His current work is in the field of word and sacrament: the intersection of symbolic activity and language as it creates insights into the Christian proclamation of grace. Central to his work is a fascination with the power of liturgy and preaching in the transformation of consciousness.

Father Fragomeni holds an S.T.B. and M.A. from the University of Louvain in Belgium, as well as an M.A., M. Music and Ph.D. from the Catholic University of America. He is frequently a speaker at national conferences and events. Father Fragomeni is the author of many books including *The Eucharist (50 questions from the Pews)*; *In Shining Splendor: Fifty Eastertime Meditations on the Exsultet*; *Come to the Feast: An Invitation to Eucharistic Transformation*; and *Blessed Art Thou Mother, Lady, Mystic, Queen*.

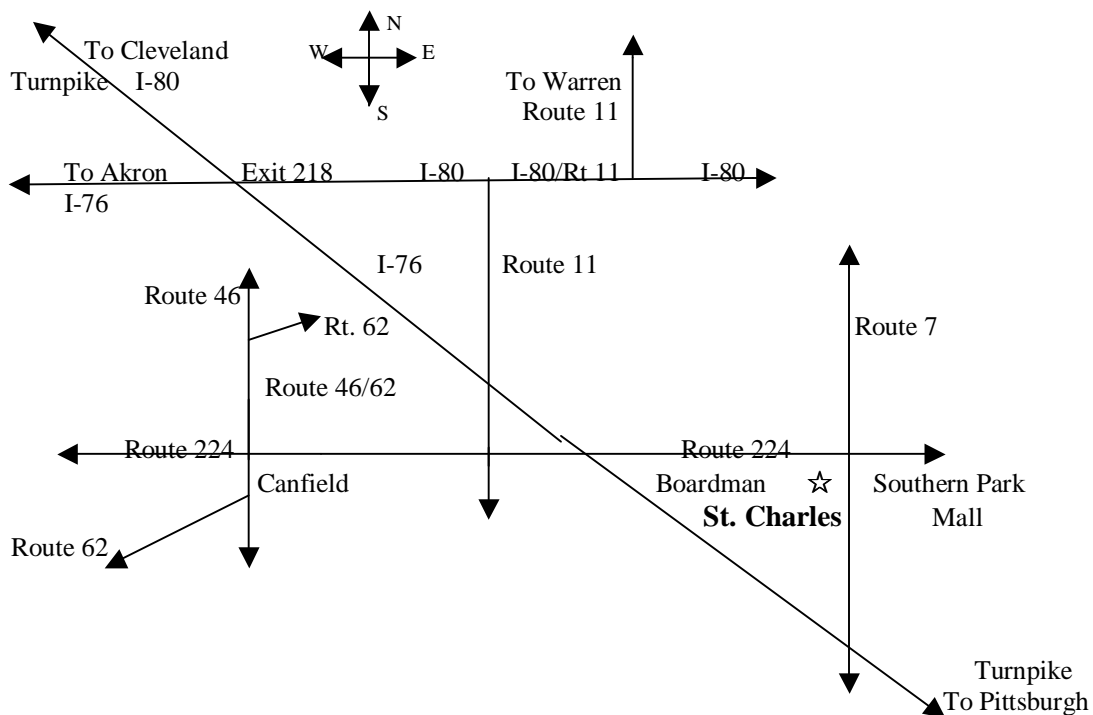
